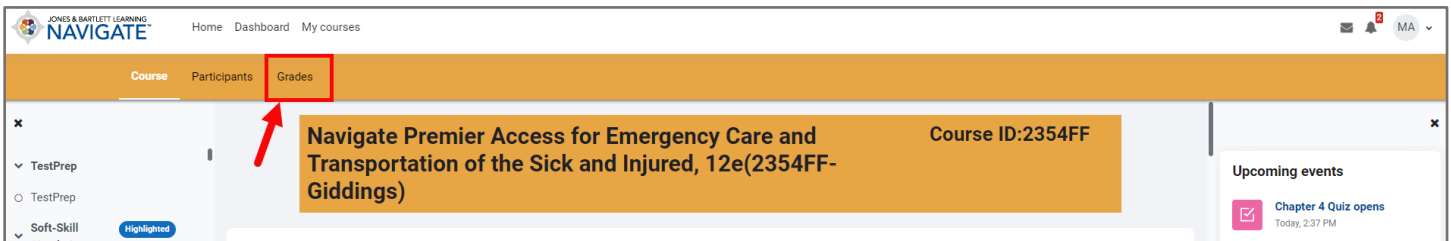


## How to Review Quiz Results

This document contains instructions on how to review quiz results in Navigate. **Note:** Your ability to review quiz scores and feedback may be limited by your instructor. Consult with your course administrator or instructor in the event they are hidden from you.

1. You may review quiz results and feedback at any time by clicking on the quiz itself from within the course. One easy way to find the quiz is to access your User Report by clicking on the **Grades** button in the course navigation bar at the top of the page.



2. Your **User Report**, which contains your course scores, will open. Gradable activities display vertically on the left-hand side under the **Grade item** column and corresponding scores will populate under the **Grade** and **Percent** columns to the right.
