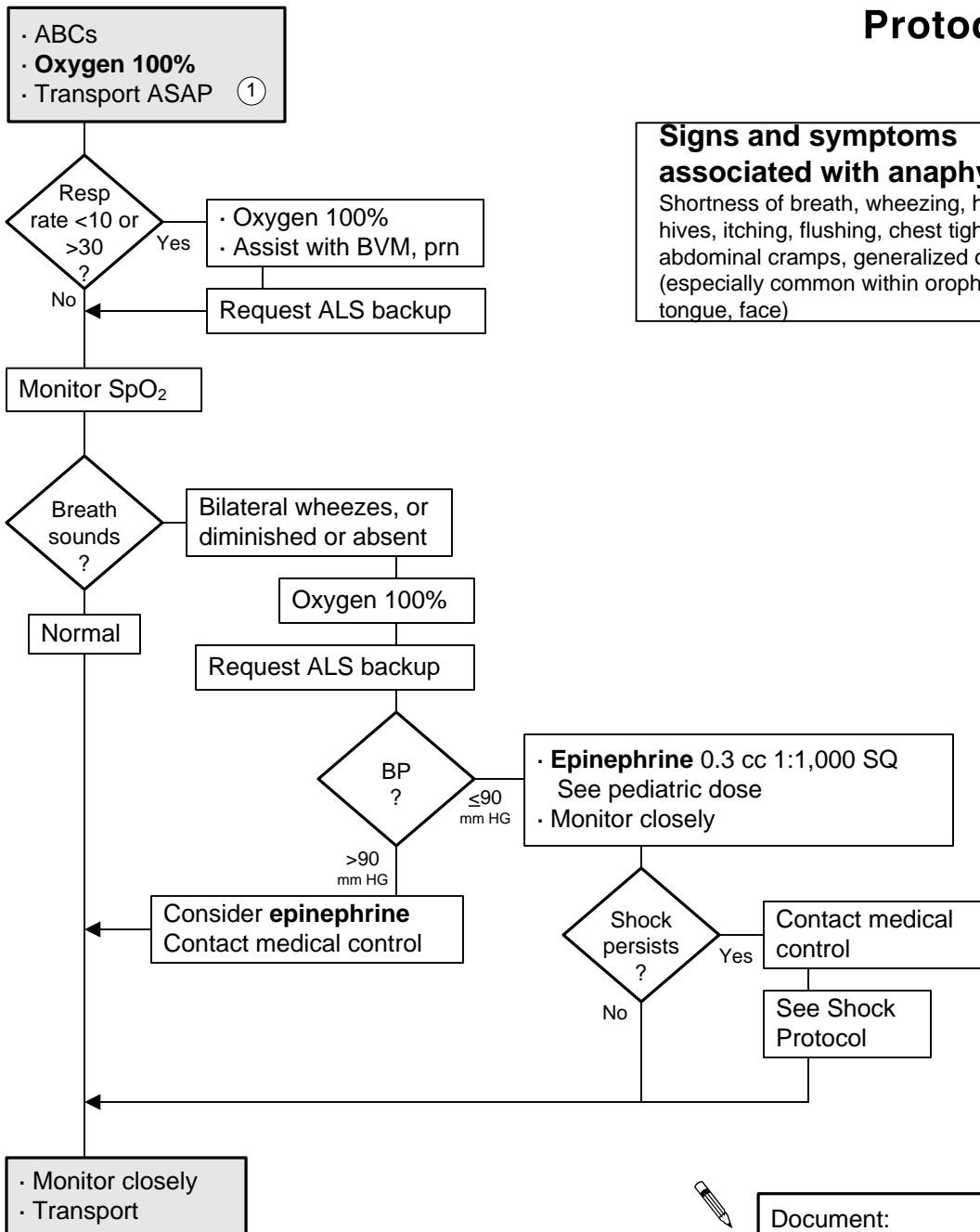


Allergic Reaction/Anaphylaxis

BLS Protocol



Signs and symptoms associated with anaphylaxis:
Shortness of breath, wheezing, hoarseness, hives, itching, flushing, chest tightness, nausea, abdominal cramps, generalized or local edema (especially common within oropharynx, lips, tongue, face)

Document:

- Airway
- Respiratory effort
- Lung sounds
- Vital signs, SpO₂
- Signs and symptoms
- Request for ALS backup
- Skin color
- Treatment

1 Bee sting: Gently remove stinger if still present.
