## Installing JBLearning's LTI Advantage in Blackboard


This document provides steps for configuring and enabling JBLearning's LTI 1.3 within your integrated Blackboard Learning Management System (LMS). **Note:** installation requires System Administrator permissions. If JBLearning LTI 1.3 is set up in Blackboard, skip these steps.

## **Summary of Steps**

- <u>Disable the JBLearning LTI 1.1 Tool</u> (Skip to the section below if your institution never used the JBLearning LTI 1.1 tool)
- Install the JBLearning LTI 1.3 Tool

## **Disable the JBLearning LTI 1.1 Tool**

- 1. If you have never used the JBLearning LTI 1.1 Tool, you can skip directly to the <u>next</u> section.
- 2. Access LTI Tool Providers from Administrator Tools.










1) Find the LTI 1.1 Tool that is using lti.jblearning.com for the Provider Domain and click edit. **Note:** We recommend renaming the Provider Domain at this step in the process. Once the 1.3 is fully set up and verified working, then the LTI 1.1 tool can be deleted.



2) Rename the Provider Domain to something like archive.lti.jblearning.com and click submit.











3) Once you rename the Provider Domain, continue to the steps for installing the 1.3 tool in Blackboard.

## **Install the JBLearning LTI 1.3 Tool**

1) Open the Self-Service Page link found within the JBLearning email you received. Then enter the Pass Key in the field provided and click Submit. **Please note:** The Pass Key is valid for 30 days. If more than 30 days have passed, please contact us to request a new Pass Key.




2) Submitting the Pass Key opens JB Learning's Edit Platform page. The only information that needs to be entered is the Base URL. The rest of the page will already be filled out. The Base URL is your Blackboard's web URL including https://. For example, https://myinstitution.blackboard.com. The Client Id on this page will be added later in the process when registering the LTI 1.3/Advantage Tool in your Blackboard.










3) To begin the installation of the LTI Tool, sign in to **Blackboard** as an administrator and navigate to the **LTI Tool Providers** option located within the **Integrations** section.






4) Under LTI Tool Providers, click Register LTI 1.3/Advantage Tool at the top of the page.



5) In the Client ID field, enter the **Application ID** provided by JB Learning, and click on the **Submit** button at the bottom of the page.










6) On the subsequent page, confirm that all three User Fields to Send options are selected and that the Allow Grade Service Access feature is enabled. Proceed by clicking Submit at the bottom of the page.



7) Go back to Administrator Tools and select Manage Placements for the JB Learning 1.3 Tool.













8) Select Create Placement.



9) Assign an appropriate name to the **Placement** and **Handle**, such as "JBLearning Prod 1.3 Deep Link."












10) Scroll down, enter "https://lti.jblearning.com/lti\_1\_3/deep\_link" into the **Target Link URI**, and click submit.
